

## Transcript - NEC Meetings - Fun Valley Discussion 6th and 19th December 2014 and 27 June 2015

### 6 DECEMBER 2014 EXCERPT

Jordaan introduces the Fun Valley matter for the very first time in an NEC Meeting

*Montshiwa:* We cannot go and demolish them. We cannot go and destabilize them. They are there. They're doing their work. If their work is to criticize us, let us then continue showing that that the decisions that we take are formidable and we know what we are doing, and we'll continue to take those decisions. Let us not even engage into now taking the fight to them, let them speak. If they speak, they speak their opinions and we know exactly what we can do. My conclusion is that let's not waste time with what they say. Let them say it and continue to do what is good for this country, or we're going to waste our energies on something that we should not.

*Jordaan:* It's an external factor. We have got no control over it. Thank you. The matter is now closed. Thank you very much, Mr. Rakoma, I'm not recognizing you. Uh, thank you. Uh, then the other two items here is the development agency. On the second page, you'll see, uh, the uh, the report of the development agency, the CEO informed me that TotalSport has now signed that contract, uh, of 8.7.

*Jordaan:* Uh, is that your academy? It's the join, uh, the 8.7 for Johannesburg Academy. And then, uh, the, for operating expenses, 4.5 million. And you'll see the, the rest of the report there. The CEO of the development agency is not here. Uh, last week in the Eastern Cape there was a, the PPC function of 288 coaches were given certificates there.

*Tsichlas:* Coaches, the coaches program in the Eastern Cape. Um, but as I say, he's not here. So therefore, uh, the report is just noted.

*Jordaan:* Yes.

*Nkompela:* Sorry, President for disturbing. I want to check whether there is not an omission e approval of e referees code of conduct. Referees code of conduct to the same report of the committee. Omission.

*Jordaan:* The referees?

*Nkompela:* Yes.

*Tsichlas:* President, I did request that this is the issue that the CEO will, you know, deal with, but it hasn't happened.

*Jordaan:* Can we refer that matter to the Emergency Committee?

*Mumble:* That's exactly what I was going... [crosstalk]

*Jordaan:* Good. The last matter is the Legacy Trust. There is a report on the Legacy Trust. Uh, the only thing that we must report here is that the legacy trust, uh, approved 82.7 million for the purchasing of a property to start the National Technical Centre and that, uh, and I think some of you saw the place already, uh, and then, uh, if you've not seen it, you can go and see

it. Uh, and then FIFA said that, uh, they will give \$600,000 times four. We can apply for four, uh, GOAL projects, which is about 2.4 million. Uh, US dollars. It's about another 24 million to the 80 million. So it's a project well over eight-- a hundred million. Uh, and as soon as the legal people have finalised with the technical people, you will be invited to the opening of your Technical Center and, uh, we hope that, uh, this Constitutional Congress can be held there at your own facility.

*Jordaan:* To the, you must thank the ... those two gentlemen are, are the evaluators of the Legacy Trust. So if you did not get a project, you must blame them. [laughter] Okay, that's, that's it. And uh, we are now ready to close. Can you ask Dominic to bring them? We're closing.

*Tsichlas:* Just, just to inform the members that, uh, job well done by FIFA and that, uh, the head of, uh, uh, FIFA delegation, uh, Mr Lefteris Karikiakis, he, he couldn't believe it how, you know, going to a different, of course, uh, uh, academies and talk with, uh, the office here. They couldn't believe the development that we have done, so I just wanted to announce that to everyone because he did indicate he even send the, uh, email to that. I'll show you why.

*Jordaan:* Thank you. Uh, thank you. Uh, I must look at who did not speak today. I think it's Kaizer is the only one who didn't speak. He must give us a closing remark.

## 19 DECEMBER 2014 EXCERPT

### Jordaan presents the Fun Valley Update to the NEC

*Jordaan:* That is the asset base. We said one of the problems of our financial statement was current liability versus current assets. We have to strengthen our asset base. And so this Technical Center will give us another 100 million together with SAFA House of 70 million. One issue that we want to raise, Mr. Minister, is that the land on which this stadium is, this Saffa House is, is not ours. It belongs to the government. So we want the Minister to help us to own both SAFA House and the land. But that is a project for 2015.

*Jordaan:* Revenue, sponsorship, 300 million in Legacy Trust. The legacy will pay the 82.7 million to the purchase of that National Technical Center, which means we have about 280 million. We said our target is we want to move SAFA to a billion and over. That's where we want to go.

*Jordaan:* So in financial terms, by 2022, it must be a billion-plus industry, South African football. So that is the report. That report will go to all of the members. And I think you all have copies. If there are any comments on the report, now is your time.

*Jordaan:* I will just run you through quickly some pictures of the Technical Center so that you can see what is going to happen at the Technical Center. That is the other countries' Technical Centers. In Italy, Clairefontaine. In France, you know, in 1998, when France hosted the World Cup, that World Cup team came from Clairefontaine. The World Cup winning team came from the Sports University of Cologne in Germany and went on to win the World Cup. England, St. George, and we will have our own Technical Center.

*Jordaan:* We don't have a name yet. But that is the purpose of the Center. It will be the home for coach education. Shakes will stay there. Sports science and medicine. Training home. You're like a good nurse. You sleep in your work. Coaching, we said, must be a profession. Personal development of coaches, referees, administrators. Working closely with higher education. You see what we're doing there.

*Jordaan:* Access to everybody. Physical focus of Vision 2022. That's a workshop of 2022. That's a factory where we're going to produce the players for 2022. And all the other things that we want to do there. The CEO will give you what exists there. It's 200, accommodation for 200. A conference room. Swimming pools, water fountains, and so on.

*Jordaan:* That is what exists there now as we speak. That's the rooms. That's the conference Center. That's another view of the Conference Center. That is the pool. There are lovely, bright areas there. There you can see the Center. That is the proposed plan in the Center. And we will... There are the fields that we want to build.

*Jordaan:* So, Kaiser, we're going to be your neighbour. Going to be very close to you.

*Unknown Male Speaker:* He uses it.

*Jordaan:* Oh, he uses that Center. In any case, the rent will go up. So, that is the Technical Center. So, you have an idea of what we've done. And this is a report that will go to the members, and I hope the members will be happy.

*Jordaan:* But any comments? No. There are no comments. You're happy with your work? Yes, [crosstalk]

*Rakoma:* But I only saw... If you can go a bit back in the slide. Again. I don't know who are these people. I think they are linked to us to a certain extent.

*Jordaan:* You want to see yourself there?

*Rakoma:* But I see others who are linked to us. But I don't see myself there.

*Zulu:* President, it was the elders.

## 27 JUNE 2015 EXCERPT

Jordaan asks the CEO to submit a GOAL Project application to FIFA

*Jordaan:* I just want to say to all of you, welcome. This is our first meeting at your very own property, and I think it's a huge credit to this Executive that we have taken the first step to develop what is essential for South African football to have our own Technical Center. And we must thank you because at the end of the day, you approved the plan in terms of Vision 2022 and the purchase of this place, and now we must take responsibility to accelerate the development. We must ask the CEO also to submit to FIFA now the applications and the GOAL project so that we can get the other infrastructure, the fields and so on, to complete.

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
